IF YOU HAVE FOOD ALLERGIES, note that we cannot assume any liability for adverse reactions to food consumed.

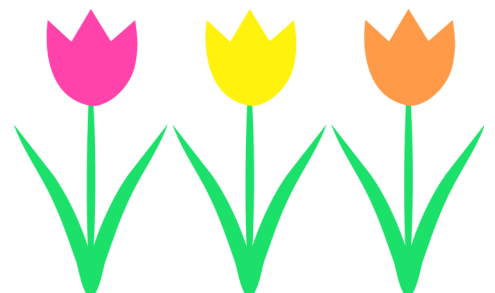
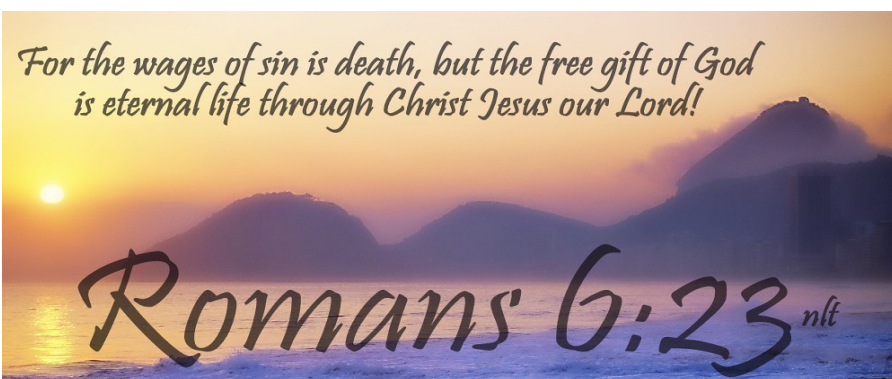
KITCHEN: If you are eating prepared foods from our kitchen, know that, at times, our kitchen uses SOME of the following items, but not limited to: Milk, eggs, nuts, peanuts, seafood, shellfish (shrimp, lobster, etc.), soybeans, wheat products. Note: these may be also an ingredient in the packaged foods.



FAMILY FOOD BOX PROGRAM

A person, with a residence that has an **APPROVED APPLICATION**, may be eligible for a **FREE** food box each month. **Food boxes can be reserved over the phone but ONLY by talking with a live operator.** (No phone messages will be returned, or boxes ordered from a message.) However, you can sign up **ONLINE** and avoid making phone calls.

If **delivered to your home**, an adult must be present to receive the **FAMILY FOOD BOX**. If no adult is present, or you are not home to receive the **FAMILY FOOD BOX** the box will be forfeited for 30 days. One **FAMILY FOOD BOX** per address.

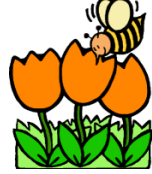

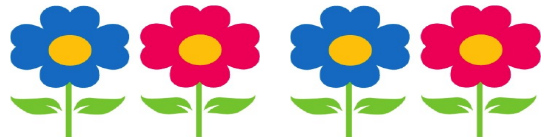

Life to the Fullest by David Jeremiah
